

NEW ZEALAND CUSTOMS SERVICE BADGES OF RANK

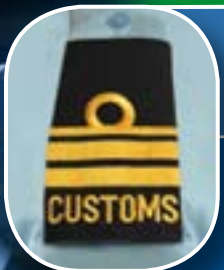
New Zealand Customs Service badges of rank are worn by Customs Officers and Managers when in uniform.

The badges of rank are always worn with the looped stripe flowing (facing) to the rear.



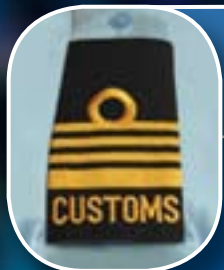
Three broad stripes, looped stripe

Comptroller



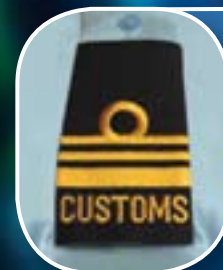
Two broad stripes, looped stripe

Deputy Comptroller



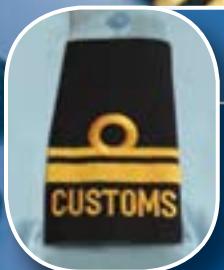
Broad stripe, two stripes, looped stripe

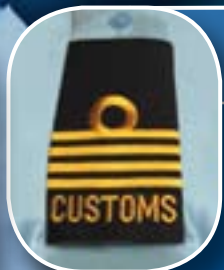
Broad stripe, one stripe, looped stripe

Port Manager with CCO direct reports



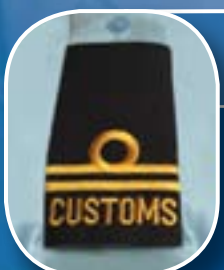
Three stripes, one looped stripe

Port Manager without CCO direct reports



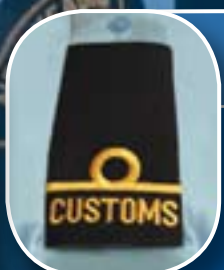
Two stripes, one looped stripe

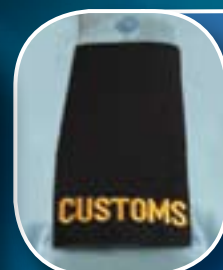
One stripe, one looped stripe
